THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF REHOBOTH BEACH ON SEPTEMBER 19, 2014, ADOPTED RESOLUTION NO. 0914-03 WHICH READS AS FOLLOWS:

## A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF REHOBOTH BEACH, DELAWARE, RELATING TO THE REPLACEMENT OF HVAC EQUIPMENT

- WHEREAS, heating, ventilation and air-conditioning (HVAC) equipment is integral to and a part of the building it services and therefore must meet all setback, side and rear yard requirements of the zoning code, and
- WHEREAS, there are instances where existing HVAC equipment is located in whole or in part in required side and/or rear yards which constitutes a legal nonconforming condition, and
- WHEREAS, HVAC equipment generally has a service life expectancy far shorter than the building of which it forms a part; and
- WHEREAS, when needing to replace HVAC equipment, having to relocate it can result in practical difficulties and unreasonable increases in cost.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Rehoboth Beach, Delaware, that replacement HVAC equipment shall hereafter be permitted to be located, as many other elements of a building are, in the same location as the equipment being replaced regardless of the fact that the location may in whole or in part be within a required side and/or rear yard.
