Members of the public wishing to speak will be required to pre-register with Donna Moore, at [dmoore@cityofrehoboth.com](mailto:dmoore@cityofrehoboth.com) at least two (2) full business days prior to the meeting.

Citizen comment will be administered by a moderator to ensure everyone has an opportunity to comment. You will not be able to speak until called upon by the moderator.

Registered members of the public joining the meeting on the phone or by computer will be provided an opportunity to make comments during the agenda topic after discussion by the Board of Elections. Speakers shall state their name and address.

The City will stream this meeting using the same technology it uses for its chamber broadcast that can be viewed on the City portal at [/Portal/](#) or YouTube. This stream will broadcast the meeting, the public will not be able to comment or speak using this broadcast. This stream will experience a 30-second delay.
