Sealed bids will be received by the City of Rehoboth Beach for the City of Rehoboth Beach Effluent Pumping Station, City Project #2017-003.

A printed copy of the contract documents can be purchased during normal working hours at the Office of the City Manager, City Hall Modular Unit, 229 Rehoboth Avenue, Post Office Box 1163, Rehoboth Beach, Delaware 19971.

The Work generally consists of constructing, complete with all equipment and accessories, a new Effluent Pumping Station to be designed for a firm pumping capacity of 7.2 mgd, including vertical turbine pumps, cast-in-place wet well, site work, piping, valves, instrumentation, electrical and controls.


Sealed Bids will be received by the City of Rehoboth Beach until **2:00 p.m., local time, on Tuesday, July 11, 2017**, in the City Manager's Office located in the City Hall Modular Unit, at 229 Rehoboth Avenue. Bids will be opened on same day at approximately 2:30 p.m. at 219 Rehoboth Avenue, Rehoboth Beach Volunteer Fire Department, on the 2nd floor. A **mandatory pre-bid meeting** will be held at the Rehoboth Beach Volunteer Fire Department, on the 2nd floor at **1:30 p.m., Thursday, June 15, 2017**.

The project will be financed through the Delaware Water Pollution Control Revolving Loan Fund, Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control, State of Delaware and all provisions shall apply. The conditions of the CWSRF loan govern the requirements for this Project. The Project must comply with federal Davis-Bacon wage rates, Delaware State Prevailing Wages, American Iron and Steel (AIS) requirements, and the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) policy, which are included within the Bidding Documents.

Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope and shall be marked clearly in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Requirements for a 5% Bid Bond, 100% Performance Bond and a 100% Payment Bond are included in the Contract Documents.

Each Bidder must deposit with his Bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the Instructions for Bidders. The City of Rehoboth Beach reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and make such award as appears most advantageous to the City.
