



THE CITY OF REHOBOTH BEACH
FOURTH MODIFICATION TO
PROCLAMATION OF CIVIL EMERGENCY
AND
ORDER CONCERNING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2020 at 3:00 p.m., the Governor of the State of Delaware issued a State of Emergency due to the public health threat of COVID-19, which became effective as of 8:00 a.m. on March 13, 2020 (the “COVID-19 State of Emergency”);

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 22-3 of the Municipal Code of the City of Rehoboth, on March 22, 2020, the Mayor of the City of Rehoboth Beach proclaimed a civil emergency in response to the COVID-19 pandemic (“Civil Emergency Proclamation”);

WHEREAS, the Mayor implemented an Amended First Modification to the Civil Emergency on May 15, 2020;

WHEREAS, the Mayor implemented a Second Modification to the Civil Emergency on July 1, 2020;

WHEREAS, the Mayor implemented a Third Modification to the Civil Emergency on July 7, 2020;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Rehoboth Beach desire to implement measures that will support local businesses during the COVID-19 State of Emergency;

WHEREAS, implementing a “Meterless Monday” initiative for a limited period of time will encourage patronage of local businesses during the COVID-19 State of Emergency;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Rehoboth Beach convened a public meeting on July 21, 2020 to consider recovery measures to be implemented within the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PAUL KUHNS, Mayor of the City of Rehoboth Beach, Delaware, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Municipal Code of the City of Rehoboth Beach, do hereby **ORDER** this Fourth Modification to the Proclamation of Civil Emergency and Order Concerning the COVID-19 Pandemic issued on March 22, 2020, as follows:

1. From and including Monday July 27, 2020 through and including Monday August 31, 2020, the parking meter fees established in Section 92-73 of the Municipal Code of the City of Rehoboth Beach shall be suspended on each Monday from 4 p.m. until 10 p.m.
2. This Order has the force and effect of law and may be enforced in accordance with Section 22-11 of the City of Rehoboth Beach Municipal Code.
3. This Fourth Modification to the March 22, 2020 Proclamation of Civil Emergency and Order shall take effect immediately upon the Mayor's execution.
